

Cyprus lifts covid restrictions from June 01, 2022

The authorities of Cyprus have decided to lift the restrictions previously imposed in the country due to the COVID-19 pandemic, starting from June 01, 2022

According to the information received from the Embassy of Cyprus in Krasnodar, the country has decided to lift restrictions on entry into the country, introduced due to the COVID-19 pandemic, starting from June 01, 2022.

This eliminates the need for a vaccination/recovery/negative PCR test for COVID-19 upon entry into the country.

Please note that citizens of Russian Federation require a visa to enter Cyprus. The issuance of pro-visas under a simplified procedure is suspended at the moment and it is necessary to receive a national visa through the Embassy of Cyprus in advance. It is also still possible to enter Cyprus with a multiple-entry Schengen visa (if any).
