

## From May 30, Russians will be able to get a visa on arrival in Indonesia

Starting May 30, 2022, Russian citizens can apply for an Indonesian visa on arrival at airports or ports in Indonesia

From May 30, 2022, Russian citizens will be able to enter Indonesia without a visa, applying for it on the spot (VOA – Visa On Arrival). This visa is issued at airports or ports upon arrival of foreign citizens to the territory of Indonesia.

The validity of this visa will be limited to a period of 30 calendar days with the possibility of one extension for another 30 calendar days, the cost of initial processing will be \$35.

Earlier, due to coronavirus restrictions, Russian citizens wishing to enter Indonesia and Bali were forced to apply for a business visa (B 211). Such a visa was issued only through Indonesian host companies. For citizens of Russia traveling for tourism purposes, entry into Indonesia was closed.
